



TH1 Install Manual

UPDATES

Like every software application, TH1 is continuously evolving and improving. We advise you to always check for possible updates before installing, and to do the same after installation, from time to time.

HOW TO SET UP TH1

Please follow the instructions below to set up and authorize TH1.

1. INSTALLATION

INSTALL TH1 FROM THE CD

1. Search the CD content and locate the TH1 Standalone version installer;
2. Run the installer.
3. Important: installing TH1 Standalone is strongly recommended to ease up product authorization.
4. Search the CD content and locate the version(s) of TH1 you wish to use.
5. Run the installer(s) of such versions.

INSTALL TH1 FROM THE WEB SITE

1. Go to <http://www.overloud.com> and navigate the web site to the download page.
2. Locate and download the installer of TH1 Standalone and all the versions you wish to use on your computer.
3. Run the installer(s).
4. Important: installing TH1 Standalone is strongly recommended to ease up product authorization.

2. AUTHORIZATION

AUTHORIZE WITH A LICENSE FILE (SOFTWARE LICENSE)

1. Run TH1 Standalone;
2. The InterLok window shows up, click Authorize then, on next window uncheck "Use my iLok smart key" and proceed;
3. Click "Save license request file..." and select a handy place to save the ILR InterLok License Request file (e.g. your Desktop or Documents folder). The file will be given an ".ilr" file extension;
4. Go to <http://www.overloud.com> and navigate the web site to the license file authorization form and fill it with the information required. Then submit the ILR file you just saved;
5. You will be prompted to download the ILF InterLok License File (".ilf" file extension) immediately, and an email with the same file attached will be sent to you for your records;
6. If you had quitted at step 4, run step 1 to 2 again;
7. Now click "Read license file..." and select the ILF file you just downloaded;
8. TH1 will inform you that your installation was successfully authorized.



*As stated on the EULA, End User License Agreement, you can authorize up to three installations with the license file, provided that you do that only on computers you own.

AUTHORIZE WITH A LICENSE FILE (SOFTWARE LICENSE) USING A SEPARATE COMPUTER WITH INTERNET CONNECTION

1. Run TH1 Standalone;
2. The InterLok window shows up, click Authorize then, on next window uncheck "Use my iLok smart key" and proceed;
3. Click "Save license request file..." and select a handy place to save the ILR InterLok License Request file (e.g. your Desktop or Documents folder). The file will be given an ".ilr" file extension;
4. Move the ILR InterLok License Request file to a computer with Internet connection;



5. Go to <http://www.overloud.com> and navigate the web site to the license file authorization form and fill it with the information required. Then submit the ILR file you just saved;
6. You will be prompted to download the ILF InterLok License File (".ilf" file extension) immediately, and an email with the same file attached will be sent to you for your records;
7. Move the ILF InterLok License File to the computer with TH1 installed
8. If you had quitted at step 4, run step 1 to 2 again;
9. Now click "Read license file..." and select the ILF file you just downloaded;
10. TH1 will inform you that your installation was successfully authorized.

*As stated on the EULA, End User License Agreement, you can authorize up to three installations with the license file, provided that you do that only on computers you own.

AUTHORIZE YOUR INSTALLATION WITH AN iLok USB SMART KEY

1. Go to <http://www.overloud.com> and navigate the web site to the iLok license authorization form and fill it with the information required and specify the iLok user account name (your iLok.com login name) where you want the iLok license to be uploaded. Submit your request;
2. Connect the iLok USB smart key, go to <http://www.ilok.com>, log in to the iLok account and transfer the pending license to your iLok key;
3. Now that you have the TH1 license stored on the iLok key, you can move the iLok to each computer of your own and just run TH1 there;
4. Connect the iLok to a computer, install and run TH1 on that computer.



*As stated on the EULA End User License Agreement, you can run TH1 on separate computers, provided that you do that only on computers you own.

3. INSTALLATION FAQ - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Do I need to have an iLok to run TH1?

A. Not necessarily. You can choose to authorize TH1 with a license file, which doesn't require you to have an iLok.

Q. Should I authorize every format of TH1 separately?

A. No. After you authorized one format, the other ones will be authorized as well.

Q. How many authorizations am I allowed to do?

A. You can authorize a single license of TH1 (hence, a unique TH1 serial number), on up to three (3) computers and/or on the iLok (if you have one). You can actually choose the copy protection system that better fits your needs and even make use of both of them for a single license of TH1.

Q. Can I install TH1 on a computer that is not connected to the Internet?

A. Yes. The authorization process, however, needs to be done with a computer with an Internet connection.

Q. TH1 unexpectedly quits, hangs or doesn't start at all. What to do?

A. First update TH1 to the latest version: go to <http://www.overloud.com>, navigate to the download page and select the format of your preference.
Then update the InterLok drivers from here: <http://www.interlok.com/dldrvr.html> and reboot your system.

Q. Why do I need to install TH1 Standalone in order to authorize my installation?

A. Some hosts and some host validation systems may fail to show up the authorization window and this may require you to force-quit, it may stall the system or simply prevent you from successfully authorizing it. While authorization of the VST, AU and RTAS versions may work in your case, we strongly recommend to authorize TH1 Standalone.
